### **ROCK ISLAND MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO COCAINE CHARGE, GETS 13-YEAR PRISON TERM**

August 18, 2017

A Rock Island man is headed to prison for possessing a large amount of cocaine he planned to sell.

24-year-old **Kendall D. Randolph** today agreed to a sentence of 13 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections in exchange for a guilty plea to unlawful possession of a controlled substance, Class X felony.

Associate judge David R. Kliment accepted the plea.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Andrew Whitfield stated during that plea hearing that 10:30 a.m. Jan. 24, 2016, a Kane County Sheriff's deputy stopped a white Hyundai Sonata near mile marker 101 in far western Kane County for a traffic violation. Randolph was riding in the front passenger seat. While speaking with the vehicle occupants, the deputy asked to search the vehicle and was given consent. During the search the deputy found a plastic bag that contained more than 400 grams of cocaine. Randolph acknowledged that the cocaine was his and that the driver did not know about it.

In addition to the prison term, Randolph was fined \$39,000.

According to Illinois law, Randolph is eligible for day-for-day credit. He receives credit for 5 days served in the Kane County jail. He had been free on bond.
