AURORA MAN GETS 21 YEARS FOR SEX ASSAULT OF CHILD

An Aurora man convicted in May for sexually assaulting a child he knew has been sentenced to more than two decades in prison.

Kane County Circuit Judge Donald M. Tegeler, Jr., today sentenced 31-year-old **Angel Gallegos-Ortiz** to 21 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

A Kane County jury on May 17, 2017, convicted Gallegos-Ortiz of three counts of predatory criminal sexual assault of a child, Class X felonies.

Kane County prosecutors presented evidence that between August 2013 and April 2015, Gallegos-Ortiz sexually assaulted the child, who was younger than 13 years old.

In addition to the prison term, Gallegos-Ortiz must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

According to Illinois law, Gallegos-Ortiz must serve at least 85 percent of the sentence. He receives credit for 855 days served in the Kane County jail, where he has been held since his arrest.

The case was prosecuted by Kane County Assistant State's Attorneys Lori Schmidt and Reagan Pittman, who are assigned to the Kane County Child Advocacy Center.
