### **AURORA MAN GUILTY OF 2016 VIOLENT STABBING AT BAR**

September 13, 2017

An Aurora man faces a minimum prison sentence of 10 years after he was convicted for stabbing a man in the neck.

A Kane County jury today convicted **Michael W. Moser-Booth** of armed violence, a Class X felony. The jury deliberated for about 3½ hours before reaching the verdict.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorneys Lori Anderson and Kelley Flinn presented evidence that at about 11 p.m. April 12, 2016, Moser-Booth entered a tavern in the 700 block of Hill Avenue, Aurora, stabbed the victim in the left side of the neck and fled. Moser-Booth knew the victim and had targeted him. The victim continues to suffer from what doctors consider to be permanent injuries.

Associate Judge Linda S. Abrahamson set Moser-Booth's next court appearance for 1:30 p.m. Oct. 27, 2017, for motions and sentencing. Moser-Booth faces a sentence of between 10 and 30 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

Moser-Booth had been free on \$5,000 bond. Bond was revoked upon conviction and authorities took Moser-Booth into custody.
