### **ELGIN DRUG DEALER HEADS BACK TO PRISON FOR SELLING COCAINE**

An Elgin cocaine dealer is returning to prison after his third drug delivery conviction.

Kane County Associate Judge David R. Kliment today sentenced 41-year-old **Roosevelt D. Williams** to 12 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

Judge Kliment on Aug. 24, 2017, convicted Williams of unlawful delivery of a controlled substance within 1,000 feet of a church, Class X felony. Williams waived his right to a jury trial.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorneys Bianca Camargo and Andrew Whitfield presented evidence in court that on Feb. 1, 2016, a co-defendant agreed to sell cocaine to an undercover officer in exchange for \$240. The co-defendant went to Williams' Elgin home, where he gave her 1.1 grams of cocaine. The co-defendant then gave the cocaine to the officer in exchange for the \$240. The transaction took place about 800 feet from a church in the 500 block of Standish Street, Elgin.

Williams was subject to enhanced sentencing because of his history of drug dealing. He was convicted of drug delivery offenses in 1998 and 2004 in Kane County, the latter a Class X felony, and served one previous term in prison.

According to Illinois law, Williams is eligible for day-for-day sentencing. He receives credit for 676 days served in the Kane County jail, where he has been held since his arrest in lieu of \$200,000 bail.
