## AURORA DRUG DEALER SENT TO PRISON

January 9, 2018

An Aurora drug dealer is headed to prison for possessing a large amount of marijuana he planned to deliver.

Associate Judge David R. Kliment on Jan. 4, 2018, sentenced 27-year-old **Jamari M. Suggs** to five years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

Suggs pleaded guilty Oct. 12, 2017, to unlawful possession of cannabis with intent to deliver, Class 3 felony. Judge Kliment accepted the plea.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Lori Anderson stated in court that at about 6:45 p.m. Oct. 10, 2016, Aurora police stopped the 2017 Ford Fusion that Suggs was driving in the vicinity of Fifth Avenue and Spicebush Lane for an expired registration. As a police officer spoke with Suggs he saw two plastic bags containing a total of 117 grams of marijuana on the car's right rear floor. Suggs admitted the marijuana was his and that he sells marijuana.

Suggs has two prior convictions for cocaine delivery and one prior conviction for cocaine possession.

According to Illinois law, Suggs is eligible for day-for-day sentencing. He received credit for 1 day served in the Kane county jail.
