AURORA MAN GETS 6 YEARS IN PRISON FOR SEXUALLY ASSAULTING CHILD

An Aurora man is headed to prison for sexually assaulting a child he knew.

47-year-old **Ervey Dominquez** on Jan. 25, 2017, agreed to a sentence of 6 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of corrections in exchange for a guilty plea to criminal sexual assault, Class 1 felony.

Circuit Judge John A. Barsanti accepted the plea.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Christine Bayer stated in court that between Jan. 27, 2011, and May 31, 2014, Dominquez sexually assaulted the victim, whom he knew. The victim was younger than 17 years old.

In addition to the prison term, Dominquez must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

According to Illinois law, Dominquez must serve at least 85 percent of the sentence. He receives credit for 20 days served in the Kane County jail. Dominquez had been free on \$5,000 bond. Judge Barsanti revoked bond upon conviction.
