CARPENTERSVILLE MAN CHARGED FOR CHILD PORNOGRAPHY

June 25, 2018

A Carpentersville man faces criminal charges for possessing child pornography on his home computer.

Kane County prosecutors have charged 64-year-old **Alberto Rios** with 10 counts possession of child pornography, Class 2 felony.

Kane County State's Attorney Joe McMahon alleges that on June 21, 2018, Rios knowingly possessed at least 10 photographs and video reproductions of children younger than age 18 nude or engaged in sexual acts.

Carpentersville police served a search warrant at Rios' residence on Thursday, June 21, and took him into custody.

Rios appeared Friday, June 22, 2018, in Kane County bond court. The judge set Rios' bail at \$25,000 with 10 percent (\$2,500) to apply for bond, and set Rios' next court date for 9 a.m. June 29, 2018, in front of Circuit Judge Donald M. Tegeler, Jr., in Courtroom 311 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

Rios posted \$2,500 bond and was released.

If convicted, Rios faces a sentence of probation or a minimum of 3 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

In addition to the prison term, Ramirez would have to register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

The charges against Rios are not proof of guilt. Rios is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
