79-YEAR-OLD AURORA MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO SEX ASSAULT OF CHILD

August 1, 2018

An Aurora man will go to prison for sexually assaulting a young child he knew.

79-year-old **Inocente Delgado** on July 30, 2018, agreed to a sentence of 10 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections in exchange for a guilty plea to predatory criminal sexual assault of a child, Class X felony. Kane County Circuit Judge John A. Barsanti accepted the plea.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Andrew Leuchtmann stated in court that between May 2008 and May 2016 Delgado sexually assaulted the victim, who was younger than 13 years old. Delgado knew the victim.

In addition to the prison term, Delgado must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

According to Illinois law, Delgado must serve at least 85 percent of the sentence. He receives credit for 447 days served in the Kane County jail.

The Kane County Child Advocacy Center investigated and prosecuted the case.
