### **AURORA MAN GUILTY OF SEX CRIMES AGAINST CHILD**

September 11, 2018

An Aurora man faces a possible prison sentence for sexually abusing a child he knew.

Kane County Associate Judge David R. Kliment on Friday, Sept. 7, 2018, convicted 44-year-old **Antonio Pena (AKA Antonio Pina)** of aggravated criminal sexual abuse, 14 counts, Class 2 felony.

Pena waived his right to a jury trial.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorneys Andrew Leuchtman and Matthew Rodgers presented evidence that between August 2016 and April 2017 Pena sexually abused the victim, who was younger than 17 years old. Pena knew the victim.

Judge Kliment set Pena's next court appearance for 1:30 p.m. Nov. 8, 2018, in Courtroom 217 at the Kane County Judicial Center for motions and sentencing. Pena faces a sentence of probation or between 3 and 7 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

In addition to the prison term, Pena must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

Pena remains free on \$10,000 bond.

ASAs Leuchtman and Rodgers are assigned to the Kane County Child Advocacy Center, which investigated the case with assistance from the Aurora Police Department.
