AURORA MAN PLEADS GUILTY FOR ATTEMPTED SEXUAL ENCOUNTER WITH CHILD

October 1, 2018

An Aurora man faces time in prison for attempting to have sex with a minor in exchange for cash.

46-year-old **Olatokunbo Olawoye** on Friday, Sept. 28, 2018, agreed to a sentence of 3 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections in exchange for a guilty plea to the offense of traveling to meet a minor, Class 3 felony.

Kane County Associate Judge David R. Kliment accepted the plea.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Christine Bayer stated in court that on March 10, 2017, Olawoye drove to a specified location in Aurora expecting to have a sexual encounter with a minor or minors.

In addition to the prison term, Olawoye must register for 10 years as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

According to Illinois law, Olawoye is eligible for day-for-day sentencing. He receives credit for 2 days served in the Kane County jail. He had been free on \$5,000 bond.

"Exploitation of children for sexual purposes is far more common than most people realize. Our office is committed to working with law enforcement to end it, whether by targeting the supply or the demand. Thanks to ASA Bayer for her continued work on these cases, and to Homeland Security Investigations and the Aurora Police Department for their work on this investigation," said Kane County ASA Greg Sams, chief of the office's Special Prosecutions Bureau.
