ST. CHARLES MAN GUILTY OF SEX ASSAULT OF CHILD HE KNEW CHRISTOPHER JACKSON FACES A MINIMUM SENTENCE OF 51 YEARS IN PRISON

November 6, 2018

A St. Charles man faces a prison sentence of at least 51 years for sexually assaulting a child he knew.

A Kane County jury today found 46-year-old **Christopher J. Jackson** guilty of:

- Criminal sexual assault, Class 1 felony, 12 counts
- Aggravated criminal sexual abuse, Class 2 felony, 2 counts

The jury deliberated for less than an hour before it reached its verdict.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorneys Matthew Rodgers and Lori Anderson presented evidence that between 2013 and 2015 Jackson sexually assaulted the victim, whom he knew. The victim was younger than 18 years old.

Circuit Judge Clint Hull set Jackson's next court appearance for 9 a.m. Dec. 20, 2018, for motions and sentencing. Jackson faces a minimum sentence of 51 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

In addition to the prison term, Jackson must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

Jackson had been free on \$7,500 bond. Judge Hull revoked Jackson's bond on conviction and ordered him into custody at the Kane County jail.

"Christopher Jackson's selfish crimes victimized an innocent child. He'll have a long time to think about that in prison. A job well done by the Child Advocacy Center, and ASAs Rodgers and Anderson," Kane County State's Attorney Joe McMahon said.
