KANE PROSECUTORS CHARGE MAN WITH MULTIPLE FELONIES FOR BEATING TWO PEOPLE IN THE HEAD WITH A HANDGUN

A man faces multiple criminal charges for beating two people in an Elgin residence while he was armed with a loaded handgun.

Kane County State's Attorney Joe McMahon has charged 41-year-old **Joshua B. Bibbins** with the offenses of:

- Armed habitual criminal, Class X felony
- Armed violence, Class X felony, 2 counts
- Aggravated battery, Class 3 felony, 2 counts

Kane County prosecutors allege in charging documents that at about 3:30 a.m. Nov. 10, 2018, Bibbins entered a residence in the 1200 block of Fleetwood Drive, Elgin, while in possession of an FNH .40-caliber handgun. Bibbins struck one of the victims in the head with the gun, causing great bodily harm, then struck the second victim in the face with the handgun, causing great bodily harm. Bibbins also discharged the handgun.

Bibbins' next court appearance is set for 9 a.m. Friday, Nov. 16, 2018, in front of Circuit Judge John A. Barsanti in Courtroom 319 at the Kane County Judicial Center. Bibbins remains in the Kane County jail in lieu of \$250,000 bail.

The charges against Bibbins are not proof of guilt. Bibbins is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
