CARPENTERSVILLE MAN GUILTY FOR SEXUALLY ASSAULTING CHILD

December 18, 2018

A Carpentersville man faces a mandatory prison sentence for sexually assaulting a young child he knew.

Circuit Judge Donald M. Tegeler, Jr., on Monday, Dec. 17, 2018, found 30-year-old **Michael Martinez** guilty of the offense of predatory criminal sexual assault of a child, Class X felony.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorneys Lori Schmidt and Andrew Leuchtman presented evidence that between April 2014 and June 2014 Martinez sexually assaulted a child he knew. The victim was younger than 13 years old.

Judge Tegeler set Martinez's next court appearance for 1:30 p.m. Feb. 22, 2019, in Courtroom 311 at the Kane County Judicial Center for motions and sentencing. Martinez faces a sentence of between 6 and 60 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

In addition to the prison term, Martinez must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

After the conviction, Judge Tegeler revoked bond and ordered Martinez held in the Kane County jail. Martinez had been free on \$5,000 bond.
