BAIL SET AT \$3 MILLION FOR AURORA MAN ACCUSED OF STRANGLING GIRLFRIEND TO DEATH

December 12, 2020

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie Mosser has charged 21-year-old **Getzuri Arellano** with the offense of first-degree murder, 2 counts, in the Wednesday morning strangulation death of 20-year-old Natalie Jimenez of Aurora.

Kane County prosecutors allege that early the morning of Dec. 9, 2020, Arellano and Jimenez were arguing. Arellano strangled Jimenez, causing her death.

Arellano appeared today in Kane County bond court. His bail is set at \$3 million with 10 percent (\$300,000) to apply for bond.

His next court appearance is set for 9 a.m. Dec. 18, 2020, in Courtroom 217 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

If convicted, Arellano faces a sentence of between 20 and 60 years of imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

The Aurora Police Department conducted the investigation.

The charges against Arellano are not proof of guilt. Arellano is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
