SOUTH ELGIN MAN FACES ATTEMPT MURDER CHARGE AFTER WEDNESDAY MORNING STABBING

October 1, 2021

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie Mosser has charged 33-year-old **Jordan S. Christensen** with the offenses of:

- Attempt first-degree murder, Class X felony
- Armed violence, Class X felony
- Aggravated domestic battery, Class 2 felony
- Aggravated battery/great bodily harm, Class 3 felony

Kane County prosecutors allege that during the morning of Sept. 29, 2021, Christensen cut the victim's throat with a spring-loaded knife and stabbed the victim on the left side of the neck and near the victim's ear multiple times, causing great bodily harm.

Christensen knows the victim.

The South Elgin Police Department and the Kane County Major Crimes Task Force conducted the investigation.

Christensen appeared today in Kane County bond court. Kane County Judge Julia Yetter set Christensen's bail at \$500,000, with 10 percent (\$50,000) to apply for bond. Judge Yetter set Christensen's next court appearance for 9 a.m. Oct. 13, 2021, in Courtroom 313 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The charges against Christensen are not proof of guilt. Christensen is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
