JOSE SALINAS OF AURORA GETS 25 YEARS FOR REPEATED SEXUAL ASSAULTS

RE: José C. Salinas: Age 43 (d.o.b. 11-16-1978), of the 700 block of Claim Street, Aurora, Illinois. Case No. 2021CF908.

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser announces that Judge Salvatore LoPiccolo has sentenced 43-year-old **José C. Salinas** to 25 years of imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

Salinas previously pleaded guilty to the offense of aggravated criminal sexual assault, Class X felony.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Hillary Sadler stated in court that, between April 2010 and June 2013, Salinas sexually assaulted the victim multiple times. Salinas knew the victim.

In accordance with Illinois law, Salinas must serve at least 85 percent of the sentence. He receives credit for 443 days served in the Kane County jail.

ASA Sadler said: "Thanks to this victim for her bravery and for believing in our office as we sought justice on her behalf. It took her eight years to muster the courage to report this defendant's crimes against her. I want all victims of sexual assault to know that when they are ready to talk, we are here to listen. Thanks also to Det. Ben Grabowski and Officer Gianna Salerno of the Aurora Police Department for their fine investigation."
